



Arrival into the UK from the amber list countries including USA & EU countries

STEPS TO FOLLOW FOR TRAVEL TO AND FROM ENGLAND.

1

People who have been fully vaccinated with a jab approved by the EU or US authorities no longer need to quarantine upon arrival in England. Before you fly obtain a negative PCR COVID test at least 3 days prior to travelling.

- You do this via your home country's recommended list of official PCR testing providers. Check your own Government's website or Airline's website for details of official providers in your home country.

Also before you fly, it is a UK legal requirement that you complete your UK Government Passenger Locator Form online.

Before you arrive in England, you must book your PCR COVID tests to be taken on day 2 of your stay. This is a legal requirement.

- You will have pre-booked your Day 2 PCR tests via one of the following recommended UK Government Approved Testing Providers:-
